## **REGISTRATION**

Registration for each Show closes at 5:00 on the Wednesday immediately preceding that Show. Registration forms may be mailed to Frenchtown Riding Club, 39 Warsaw Road, Frenchtown, NJ 08825 or emailed to [FrenchtownRidingClub@gmail.com](mailto:FrenchtownRidingClub@gmail.com). Riders may also register by calling 908-628-9441.

## **FEES**

Entry Fee: \$25 per show. Non-refundable.

Class Fee: \$15 per class for FRC members. \$20 per class for nonmembers.

Trainer fee: \$60 per show for all FRC members showing on FRC horses. Show trainer required for FRC non-boarding members, optional for FRC boarding members, and not available to non-FRC-members.

All show fees are subject to NJ sales tax (6.63%).

All fees are due at the time of Registration.

## **RIDER AGE**

Rider's age, for the purposes of determining eligibility for any Class in these Shows, shall be the Rider's actual age at the time of that Show.

## **CHECK-IN**

All riders must check in at the Show Desk at least 15 minutes to the start of their first scheduled Class.

## **CLASS TIMES**

All Class times are approximate. Riders should arrive at least a half hour before their scheduled start time and should listen for the announcements.

## **SHOW ATTIRE**

Proper show attire required.

Riders ten and under should wear solid-colored jodhpurs or breeches, a button-up show shirt, a show jacket, and either paddock boots with garters or tall boots. Long hair should be in either one or two braids with appropriate ribbons.

Riders older than ten are expected to wear solid-colored jodhpurs or breeches, a button-up show shirt, a show jacket, and paddock boots (without garters or half-chaps) or tall boots. Hair should be in a snood, a hair net or braided with appropriate ribbons.

The show jacket requirement may be waived on hot days, at the sole discretion of the judge.

All riders must wear SEI-approved helmets at all times when mounted on a horse on FRC premises.

## **LOCATION**

Shows may be held in either the indoor or outdoor arena. The Show location will be announced in advance. The other arena will remain open for schooling throughout the Show.

## **PARKING**

Ample vehicle and trailer parking will be provided. Parking on the grass is permitted, but care should be taken to avoid blocking any road, driveway, building or dumpster.

## **TRAILERING IN**

Proof of negative Coggins is required at the time of Show Registration for all horses not currently stabled at FRC.

Any horse deemed to be unfit or unhealthy, at the sole discretion of FRC staff, will be barred from competition and all entry fees refunded.

Large trailers should enter from Barbertown Idell, not Warsaw Road. (Call 908-628-9441 for instructions, please, if needed.)

## **GROOMING & TACKING**

Grooming and tacking may only be done in the aisle of the barn. Riders are expected to be cooperative and considerate when doing so and must clean up after themselves.

## **SCHOOLING**

Ten-minute schooling breaks will be provided in the show arena at the start of each division, excluding the Jumper divisions.

The non-show arena will be available for schooling throughout the show.

## **JUDGING**

The Judge's decisions are final. Period.

## **FOOD & DRINK**

Food and drink will be available throughout the show. Riders and attendees are also welcome to tailgate.

## **SPECTATORS**

Spectators are highly encouraged and will be admitted free of charge. Bring your family. Bring your friends. The more, the merrier.

No pets allowed.

## **GENERAL CONDUCT**

We are a determinedly low-key, inclusive, drama-free facility, and expect that all Show competitors and spectators will behave accordingly.

## **PHOTOS & VIDEO**

Photos and video are fine, however, we ask that you refrain from sharing rider falls, as these are often very difficult events for riders that should neither be celebrated nor made light of.
